Tropical Storm Nicholas


SET PORT CONDITION NORMAL

Tropical storm Nicholas was downgraded to a tropical depression. Severe weather impacts have subsided across the southeast Texas and southwest Louisiana areas.

Therefore, effective at 9:00 a.m. CDT, September 15, 2021, the Captain of the Port (COTP), Port Arthur **returned to Port Condition Normal** for ports on the Sabine-Neches and Calcasieu Waterways including all tributaries and connecting waterways as defined in 33 CFR 3.40-28(b), including the GIWW.

Although waterways are open to traffic, mariners are reminded to use caution as debris, shoaling and other hazards resulting from tropical storm Nicholas may be present. Report any hazards to the nearest Coast Guard unit.
