

Vertical Clearance Reduction Gulf Intracoastal Waterway – Mile Marker 254 WHL

The vertical clearance under the power lines on the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway (GIWW) at Mile Marker 254 (30° 3.568'N, 093° 31.368'W) is reduced from 93 feet to approximately 77-feet until further notice. Entergy is working to rectify the situation.
