This timely knowledge will allow us to correct our processes and procedures and continuously improve our operating environment for the safety of our personnel and our mission effectiveness.

- We will have an atmosphere of trust, where our entire team is encouraged to come forward and report mistakes and errors.
- We will promptly evaluate and mitigate any safety concerns.
- We will share our mistakes and errors through the safety reporting system so our fellow shipmates throughout the Coast Guard can learn from our mistakes, errors, and insights.
- We will confidently report to our leadership when operational tempo or tasking will compromise our safety.
