.REST OF TODAY...S winds 10 to 15 kt, becoming S/SE 15 to 20 kt late. Waves 1 to 2 ft.

.TONIGHT...S winds 15 to 20 kt with gusts to 25 kt, becoming 10 kt late. Waves 1 to 2 ft, diminishing to less than 1 foot and light chop late.

.WED...SW winds 5 to 10 kt. Waves less than 1 foot and light chop. Showers likely with a chance of tstms in the afternoon.

.WED NIGHT...S winds 10 kt. Waves less than 1 foot and light chop. A chance of tstms. Showers likely.

.THU...SW winds 10 to 15 kt, becoming NW in the afternoon. Waves 1 to 2 ft, diminishing to less than 1 foot and light chop in the afternoon. A chance of showers in the morning.

.THU NIGHT...N winds 5 to 10 kt. Waves less than 1 foot and light chop.

.FRI...N winds 5 kt, becoming SE after midnight. Waves flat, increasing to less than 1 foot and light chop. Showers likely after midnight.

.SAT...S winds 5 to 10 kt, becoming NW. Waves less than 1 foot and light chop. Showers likely through the day. A chance of showers through the night.

Winds and waves higher in and near tstms.
