Lieutenant Commander Colin K. McKee assumed the duty as Executive Officer of USCGC HARRIET LANE (WMEC 903) in July of 2022 where he directly represents the Commanding Officer in execution of all assigned missions and oversees the readiness and training of the cutter's 100-person crew.

A permanent cutterman, he has more than seven years afloat, including command of a Sentinel Class fast response cutter based in Honolulu, Hawaii, as well as several Island Class patrol boats forward deployed to Manama, Bahrain.

His staff assignments include managing the Coast Guard Biometrics Program at Coast Guard Headquarters, the Current Operations Branch Chief for Security Cooperation at U.S. Indo-Pacific Command, and a Strategic Planner at the Department of Homeland Security Countering Weapons of Mass Destruction Office. In all those assignments he worked or led efforts of national significance and global impact.

Lieutenant Commander McKee graduated from the U.S. Coast Guard Academy in 2007 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Electrical Engineering. In 2022 he earned a Graduate Certificate in Countering Weapons of Mass Destruction.
