Commander Seniuk assumed command of CGC *Escanaba* in May 2025 after serving as the Chief, Waterways Management Branch for the Seventh Coast Guard District where his duties included operational control of seven cutters to support and maintain the marine transportation system in three states and two U.S. territories.

A Permanent Cutterman with 12 years of sea service, Commander Seniuk's most recent afloat tour was aboard USCGC *Bristol Bay* where he served as Commanding Officer. Previous afloat tours include service aboard the Coast Guard Cutters *Hollyhock*, *Pea Island*, *Drummond* and *Northland*. In addition to his afloat assignments, Commander Seniuk completed staff assignments as the Supervisor for

the Afloat Training Organization detachment in Norfolk, VA, Waterways Management Division Chief at Coast Guard Sector Detroit and as a Nautical Science Instructor at the United States Coast Guard Academy in New London, CT.

Commander Seniuk is a 2005 graduate of the United States Coast Guard Academy, where he earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering. He also holds a Master of Arts Degree in Education from San Diego State University and is a licensed professional mariner, holding a USCG Master's License for motor vessels up to 1,600 Gross Registered Tons.

Commander Seniuk's personal awards include the Coast Guard Meritorious Service Medal, Coast Guard Commendation Medal, Coast Guard Achievement Medal, the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal, and other unit and service awards that represent the extraordinary effort of the crews he has been fortunate to serve with.

Commander Seniuk is married to the former Lindsey LeFebvre, and they have four children, Rose, Lucy, Caleb, and Henry.
