LCDR Brittany Fifer assumed the duties as the Executive Officer of USCGC ESCANABA (WMEC 907) in July of 2026 after serving as the Chief of Instructional Systems at Training Center Cape May where she was responsible for all analysis, design, evaluation and execution of Training Center Cape May's five resident training programs including the Coast Guard's only enlisted accessions program (aka boot camp).

A cutterman by trade, LCDR Fifer served on three ships including as the Commanding Officer of USCGC ROLLIN FRITCH (WPC 1119), homeported in Cape May, the executive officer of USCGC DRUMMOND (WPB 1123), homeported in San Juan, PR, and a deck watch officer on USCGC RESOLUTE (WMEC 620), homeported in St. Petersburg, FL.

Previously, LCDR Fifer was a legislative assistant to Senator Jack Reed of Rhode Island. In that position, she served as an advisor to the Senator on myriad maritime, commerce, science, and interior policy issues.
