COVID-19 Impacts Reporting

As Admiral Timme pointed out in MSIB 09-20, the uninterrupted flow of commerce on our Marine Transportation System (MTS) is critical to both National Security and National economic well-being. During this National emergency for COVID-19 it is paramount that the Coast Guard safeguards the continued operation of the MTS to ensure our domestic supply chain continues uninterrupted.

To this end, Marine Safety Unit Port Arthur is asking facilities with a maritime nexus to report COVID-19 impacts and status using Coast Guard Form CG-11410A and to update the information as conditions change. This will provide the Coast Guard and the Department of Homeland Security greater visibility on the impacts to, and needs of, the maritime community. Reports should be sent to MSUPA-MTSRU@uscg.mil.
