Hurricane Ida

PORT CONDITION YANKEE – Calcasieu Waterway PORT CONDITION NORMAL – Sabine-Neches Waterway

Hurricane Ida is classified as a Category 4 Hurricane that will make landfall along the south, central Louisiana gulf coast. The 7 A.M. National Weather Service (NWS) advisory continues to indicates the possibility of tropical storm force winds affecting the Cameron and Calcasieu Parish areas of southwest Louisiana.

Sabine-Neches Waterway

Therefore, effective at 12 noon, August 29, 2021, the Capatin of the Port, Port Arthur <u>has</u> <u>rescinded Port Condition X-RAY and returned to Port Condition Normal</u> for the ports of Beaumont, TX; Orange, TX; Port Arthur, TX and Sabine, TX including all tributaties and connecting waterways including the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway from Mile Marker 251 – 316.8.

Calcasieu Waterway

The ports of Lake Charles, LA and Cameron, LA and the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway from Mile Marker 190.5 – 251 will remain at Port Condition YANKEE. The guidelines established in MSIB 10-21 remain in effect.

The Coast Guard will issue a Broadcast Notice to Mariners and Marine Safety Information Bulletins updating Port Conditions as needed.
