

Marine Safety Information Bulletin 26-21 November 03, 2021

Calcasieu River - Dredging Operations

All mariners are advised that Crosby Dredging, LLC will be conducting dredging operations in the vicinity of Mile Marker 19 on the Calcasieu River. The dredge will be operating 24 hours per day until 31 December, 2021, and will obstruct the navigational channel.

Crosby Dredging will need two hours notification to remove obstructions to allow vessels to pass. Recreational traffic should be able to navigate around the dredge equipment. Vessels are advised to contact the dredge SUSAN CROSBY prior to transiting through the area. The dredge SUSAN CROSBY and the on-scene tug will be monitoring VHF Radio Channel 7, 8 and 13.
