

### **Calcasieu River - Union Pacific Railroad Bridge**

All mariners are advised that the Union Pacific Railroad Bridge, located in the vicinity of mile marker 36 on the Calcasieu River, will be closed to marine traffic between the hours of 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM on Monday, May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022 to Thursday, May 19<sup>th</sup> 2022.

This closure is required for construction of a new fender system for the bridge structure. Mariners are advised to use caution when transiting. There is no alternate route for marine traffic through the affected area. Any questions can be directed to the on-site project engineer at 409-599-6893. M/V MARGARET K will be monitoring VHF channel 16 & 17.
