Sector Upper Mississippi River Orientation Guide



Captain Martin L. Malloy Sector Commander Coast Guard Sector Upper Mississippi River

Captain Malloy reported aboard as Commander, Sector Upper Mississippi River on July 11, 2014. As Sector Commander he is responsible for Coast Guard operations in all or parts of an eleven state area that includes over 2,200 miles of commercially navigable waterways on the Upper Mississippi, Missouri, and Illinois rivers and their tributaries. He leads 284 Active Duty, Reserve, and civilian personnel and over 1,100 CG Auxiliary members, where his duties include serving as Captain of the Port, Officer-in-Charge Marine Inspection, Search and Rescue Mission Coordinator, Federal Maritime Security Coordinator, and Federal On-Scene Coordinator for oil spills and hazardous materials releases. In this capacity, he is responsible for promoting safety, security, and environmental protection, while facilitating commerce.

Prior to his current assignment, Captain Malloy served on the Seventh Coast Guard District staff in Miami, Florida. As the Chief of the Prevention Division, he provided programmatic and operational oversight for all Waterways Management, Marine Inspection, Marine Investigation and Coast Guard Auxiliary functions in the Southeast United States and the Caribbean Basin.

Commissioned in 1990, Captain Malloy is a career Marine Safety, Security and Environmental Protection specialist. Operationally, Captain Malloy earned his marine inspector and investigator qualifications at Marine Safety Office New Orleans. He later honed these skills in the field as Assistant Senior Inspector of Personnel, Marine Inspector, and Senior Investigating Officer at Marine Safety Office Miami. He also served as the Executive Officer, Marine Safety Office Cleveland, and Prevention Department Head at Sector Hampton Roads.

Other staff assignments include Coast Guard Atlantic Area, Portsmouth, Virginia as Chief, Inspections and Investigations Branch where he served as a member of the Sector Implementation Team and authored the Marine Safety Unit construct. As Chief, Sectors Division, Office of Shore Forces at Coast Guard Headquarters, he was charged with leading organizational efforts to optimally staff, train and fund the Sector enterprise. Additionally, Captain Malloy trained over 800 Coast Guard inspectors and investigators as an Instructor at the Marine Inspection / Investigation School, Coast Guard Training Center, Yorktown, Virginia.

A Virginia native, Captain Malloy is a 1989 graduate of the Virginia Military Institute. He also attended the United States Naval War College where he earned a Master of Arts Degree in National Security and Strategic Studies.

Captain Malloy's personal decorations include: four Meritorious Service Medals, three Coast Guard Commendation Medals and a Commandant's Letter of Commendation Ribbon.



Commander Ryan S. Rhodes Deputy Sector Commander Coast Guard Sector Upper Mississippi River

Commander Rhodes reported aboard as Deputy Sector Commander, Sector Upper Mississippi River on July 10, 2015. As Deputy Sector Commander he provides daily oversight for all Coast Guard operations in all or parts of an eleven state area. This includes over 2,200 miles of commercially navigable waterways on the Upper Mississippi, Missouri, and Illinois rivers and their tributaries. He leads 274 Active Duty, Reserve and civilian personnel and over 1,300 CG Auxiliary members. His duties include serving as Alternate Captain of the Port, Search and Rescue Mission Coordinator, Federal Maritime Security Coordinator, Federal On-Scene Coordinator for oil spills and hazardous materials releases and Acting Officer-in-Charge, Marine Inspection.

Previously, Commander Rhodes served as a Counternarcotics and Law Enforcement assistance Project Officer at U.S. Africa Command in Stuttgart, Germany. As a project officer, he was responsible for developing requirements for and the supervision of over \$6M in security assistance projects for East and South African regions. His efforts provided support to requirements and ongoing capacity-building operations essential to training and equipping foreign partner nation law enforcement, paramilitary and military units with counternarcotics missions.

Other assignments include service as Command Center Chief, Sector Charleston; Surface Action Officer and Tactical Action Officer, Joint Interagency Task Force South, Key West, FL; Logistics Officer, Port Security Unit 307, St. Petersburg, FL; Assistant Operations Officer, Law Enforcement Officer and Group Duty Controller, Group Key West, FL. Commander Rhodes began his military career in 1996, he was commissioned through the Reserve Officer Training Corps as a Second Lieutenant and was branched Field Artillery. He served a total of four years in Army prior to accepting a direct commission into the U.S. Coast Guard in July 2000.

Commander Rhodes graduated as a Distinguished Military Graduate from the University of Central Florida with a B.S. degree and holds two masters degrees: M.A., Business and Organizational Security Management, from Webster University and a M.S. from Kansas State University in Adult, Occupational and Continuing Education. In addition, Commander Rhodes is a Graduate of the Army's Command and General Staff College.

He has earned the CG Advanced Boats Forces Insignia, CG Port Security Insignia and U.S. Army Parachutist Badge. His awards include the Joint Service Commendation Medal (2), CG Commendation Medal with "O" device (2), Navy Commendation Medal, Army Commendation Medal, CG Achievement Medal with "O" device, Army Achievement Medal (4), and the CG Commandant's Letter of Commendation with "O" device.

The traffic in St. Louis gets busy during normal commuting hours, so we recommend finding the building before your reporting date. Contact your sponsor for additional assistance. Until a GSA Federal ID card has been issued to you, you must enter the building through the front entry of the federal building. You will go through a security check point and be issued a visitors pass. The visitors pass is only valid for 1 day.
