

## CDR Joshua P. Miller Executive Officer

Commander Miller assumed the duties as Executive Officer at Air Station Houston, Texas in June 2015. He is a 1998 graduate of the U.S. Coast Guard Academy where he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Management and in 2011 earned his Master's of Science in Information Technology from the University of Maryland.

Following the Coast Guard Academy, Commander Miller served as a Deck Watch Officer and Supply Officer aboard USCGC CONFIDENCE, a 210-foot medium endurance cutter home ported in Cape Canaveral, Florida. Upon completion of his tour, he then reported to the Eighth Coast Guard District office in New Orleans, Louisiana where he served as an Intelligence Analyst in the Office of Law Enforcement (ole). While assigned to D8 (ole), he was selected for naval flight training in the summer of 2001 and earned his wings in August 2002. Commander Miller was then assigned to Air Station Detroit, Michigan as an HH-65A/B pilot. Designated an Aeronautical Engineer in 2006, Commander

Miller was assigned to Air Station Los Angeles, California where he served as the Assistant Engineering Officer for 2 years and then fleeted up to be the Aeronautical Engineering Officer from 2008 to 2010. Commander Miller also served as a unit Instructor Pilot (IP), Flight Examiner (FE) and Rotary Wing Air Intercept (RWAI) IP/FE deploying on numerous occasions annually to the National Capital Region (NCR) Air Defense Facility at Washington Regan National Airport along with several other RWAI missions supporting National Special Security Events. Commander Miller was then selected for officer post graduate training in Information Technology which he completed at the University of Maryland, College Park in the winter of 2011. Commander Miller then served a three year tour within the office of Enterprise Applications (CG-63) where he served as the Chief, Web Portals Branch and was the Systems Manager and Technical Authority for the Coast Guard's public facing world-wide web (WWW) and the internal Coast Guard Portal projects until the summer of 2015.

His personal awards include the two Coast Guard Commendation Medals, two Achievement Medals, two Letters of Commendation and others.

Commander Miller hails from Chester, Maryland. He and his wife Regan have three children, Joshua (15), Matthew (13) and Anna (11).
