



## Command Senior Chief Jeff Haynes



Senior Chief Haynes assumed duties as Reserve Command Senior Chief, Sector New Orleans on 01Oct17. His primary responsibility is to advise the Sector Commander on issues and initiatives pertaining to all Coast Guard Reserve members and their families.

Senior Chief Haynes enlisted active duty in 1989 and served onboard CGC Gentian during the Hurricane Hugo recovery efforts after which he attended ET A-School in Petaluma California. Upon graduation he was stationed at Coast Guard Station St. Simons Island and CG Station Tybee Island Georgia where he was qualified as an underway boat crewman, boarding team member and OOD. Prior to departure from active duty, Senior Chief Haynes served at ESD Charleston, SC, and in support efforts to the 1996 Olympics in Savannah, Ga.



Senior Chief Haynes continued his career in the reserve force starting in 1997 and has served at CG ESD Fort Macon, NC, CG LORSTA Jupiter Inlet, CG ESDD Miami, CG ESU Miami, FL, and Port Security Unit 308. It was during this time that he was called upon to lead multiple project initiatives in the field and participate in several hurricane disaster recovery efforts in Florida to include his most recent deployment to Key West to assist in security efforts after Hurricane Irma.

Senior Chief Haynes is a graduate of the Coast Guard Chief Petty Officer Academy (Reserve Class 35), the Coast Guard Senior Enlisted Leadership Course (class July 2016) and has a Bachelor's of Science degree in Business Administration and Management from Limestone University.

Senior Chief Haynes married to his wife Jody Haynes and has two daughters, Morgan and Madison Haynes. In his civilian life, Senior Chief Haynes serves as Senior Network Assurance Manager with Verizon Wireless in charge of Upstate South Carolina and Western North Carolina Cellular Phone Networks.
