Vertical Clearance Restriction Removed Gulf Intracoastal Waterway – Mile Marker 254 WHL

The overhead power lines on the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway (GIWW) at Mile Marker 254 (30° 3.568'N, 093° 31.368'W) that imposed a vertical clearance restriction (see MSIB 04-22) have been removed. The GIWW is open to normal traffic.
