



BMCM Robert Riemer Command Master Chief, Sector New York



Master Chief Boatswains Mate Robert Riemer assumed the duties as Command Master Chief, USCG Sector New York, in July 2020. In this role he serves as senior enlisted leader and advisor for Sector New York's more than 900 personnel, seven cutters, three small boat stations, two aids to navigation teams, and vessel traffic management system.

Prior to assuming his current role, Master Chief Riemer served as Officer in Charge of CGC HAWK where he provided leadership to a crew of 11 conducting Law Enforcement, Search and Rescue, and Port Security missions from Wilmington, NC to Atlantic City, NJ.

Master Chief Riemer also served as the Officer in Charge of Station Menemsha (2014-2018) and Station Elizabeth City (2011-2014).

His afloat assignments include USCGC YOCONA (WMEC-168) home ported in Kodiak, Alaska and USCGC TYBEE (WPB-1330) home ported in Woods Hole, Massachusetts.

In addition, Master Chief Riemer served as the Executive Petty Officer for the commissioning crew of the USCGC REEF SHARK (WPB-87371) home ported in San Juan, Puerto Rico. His ashore assignments have included; CG Station Eatons Neck, NY; Activities New York, Staten Island, NY; CG Station Fort Totten, NY, CG Station Kings Point, NY; CG Station Montauk, NY; CG Station Shinnecock, NY; and CG Station Small Moriches, NY.

Master Chief Riemer holds the Multi-Mission Afloat and Ashore Competencies. He also holds a Merchant Mariner's Certificate for Motor and Steam propelled vessels not to exceed 200 gross registered tons. In addition, he completed a Bachelor of Arts degree in Emergency and Disaster Management from American Military University. Master Chief Riemer is a graduate of Chief Petty Officer Academy Class 178 and the Senior Enlisted Leadership Course Class 57.
