

Command Senior Chief Sector Boston

Senior Chief Christopher Melleby is a native of Erial, New Jersey and a veteran of the United States Army. He enlisted in the United States Coast Guard in February of 2001 and was a member of recruit training company J-159 at Training Center Cape May.

Following recruit training, Senior Chief Melleby reported to Training Center Petaluma for Telecommunications Specialist "A" School. Upon graduation from "A" School, Senior Chief Melleby reported to Communication Station Kodiak as an SNTC where he qualified as Communications Watch Supervisor. Senior Chief Melleby then reported to Coast Guard Headquarters in Washington, DC where he served as Assistant Document Control and Security Officer for the Office of Defense Operations. After a short assignment at Coast Guard Headquarters, he transferred west to the Coast Guard Cutter MUNRO (WHEC-724) homeported in Alameda, CA and served as the Communications Division Supervisor and Electronic Keying Material System (EKMS) Manager. During this assignment, CGC MUNRO was assigned to U.S. Naval Forces Expeditionary Strike Group-5 in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. After completing his tour onboard Cutter MUNRO, Senior Chief Melleby joined the Leadership Development Center as a Leadership and Management School (LAMS) Instructor at the Training Center Petaluma Detachment. Senior Chief Melleby was then assigned to the Pacific Area / District 11 Command Center in Alameda, CA where he served as the Command Center Enlisted Advisor. Senior Chief Melleby served as the Command Senior Chief of Sector Southeastern New England from June 2013 to July 2018. Currently, Senior Chief Melleby is serving as the Command Senior Chief of Coast Guard Sector Boston.



Senior Chief Melleby is a 2006 graduate of the Coast Guard Chief Petty Officer Academy Class 136, Coast Guard Senior Enlisted Leadership Course, and Navy Senior Enlisted Academy class 197.
