

Commander Paul Mangini
Deputy Commander, U.S. Coast Guard Sector Southeastern New England



Commander Paul Mangini assumed the duties of Deputy Sector Commander of Sector Southeastern New England in August 2021. He was most recently the Commanding Officer of Marine Safety Unit (MSU) Huntington, WV since June 2018. Prior to that he served as the Supervisor of the District Response Advisory Team (DRAT) for the Eighth Coast Guard District in New Orleans, LA and alternate co-chair for Regional Response Teams (RRTs) 6, 7 and 8. He was also the Deputy Federal On-Scene Coordinator for the Gulf Coast Incident Management Phase IV Documentation Team for the response to the Deepwater Horizon Spill of National Significance.

Previously, he was the Supervisor of Marine Safety Detachment Cape Cod responsible for all commercial vessel and regulated facility inspections, marine casualty investigations, pollution response and waterways management activities for Cape Cod and the islands of Martha's Vineyard and Nantucket. Other operational tours include Senior Marine Inspector at Sector New York serving as the Vessel Enforcement Branch Chief supervising all Port State Control and Vessel Boarding and Search exams as well as Small Passenger Vessel Section Chief for inspections in the Port of NY/NJ and Deck Watch Officer on board the USCGC SPENCER (WMEC-905) homeported in Boston, MA.

Commander Mangini was assigned to the Office of Traveling Inspectors and Quality Assurance Staff at Coast Guard Headquarters in Washington, D.C. and served as a Quality Standard System Lead Auditor for the Merchant Mariner Credentialing program and Voluntary Member State Audit program. He will be reporting to Sector Southeastern New England to serve as the Deputy Sector Commander in August 2021.

He holds a Bachelor of Science in Marine and Environmental Sciences from the United States Coast Guard Academy, Master of Science in Quality Systems Management from the National Graduate School and Master of Science in Civil and Environmental Engineering from Northeastern University.

Commander Mangini is a native of West Springfield, MA and is married to the former Katherine Criniti of Hurricane, WV.
