### **MARINE SAFETY INFORMATION BULLETIN (MSIB) 018-26** **PUBLIC NOTICE OF A REGULATED NAVIGATION AREA (RNA)**

#### FALCON 9 CRS-34 ROCKET LAUNCH

The Captain of the Port Jacksonville, FL, will activate a portion of the regulated navigation area located near Cape Canaveral Space Force Station for the launch of the FALCON 9 CRS-34 ROCKET in accordance with Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 165.775

The regulated navigation area within the coordinates listed below will be activated 45 minutes prior to the FALCON 9 CRS-34 ROCKET being launched and shall remain active until the rocket is launched, or the zone has been deactivated by the Captain of the Port or their designated representative. The Captain of the Port will inform the public eight hours prior to the activation of the RNA by Broadcast Notice to Mariners on VHF-FM channel 16. Any person or vessel requesting to enter, pass through or remain in the RNA shall request authorization from the Captain of the Port or their designated representative via VHF Ch. 16. Failure to comply is punishable by a civil penalty of not more than \$117,608. Willful violation is punishable by a fine of not more than \$250,000 or imprisonment for not more than six years, or both, under the authority of 33 CFR 160.111 and Title 46, United States Code (USC), Parts 70002 and 70036. Each day of a continuing violation constitutes a separate violation.

The Captain of the Port recognizes the rights of individuals who may wish to protest or voice their opinions during this operation and will not interfere so long as the protest is conducted safely, peacefully, and outside of the established RNA. Provisions for appealing this order are contained in 33 CFR 160.7. However, all conditions of this order remain in full effect while such appeal is being processed unless specifically stayed by the District Commander. This order may be appealed orally or in writing to the Commander, Southeast Coast Guard District, through the Captain of the Port Jacksonville, at the above address.
