UCSG STATION MARBLEHEAD IS A GREAT PLACE TO BE STATIONED, IF YOU LIKE THE SMALL TOWN LIFE STYLE. IN THE WINTER IT IS PRETTY SLOW BECAUSE OF THE COLD WEATHER AND THE LAKE FREEZING OVER. THIS WOULD BE A GREAT TIME TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF COLLEGE CLASSES AND EXTRA QUALIFICATIONS. WE ALSO PULL THE 45' RB-M, AND THE 29' RB-SII OUT OF THE WATER FOR MAINTENANCE. DURING THE WINTER MONTHS WE CONDUCT ICE RESCUES WITH A 20' ALUMINUM AIRBOAT WHICH WE USE WHEN WE HAVE A SEARCH AND RESCUE CASE. IN MOST CASES A HELICOPTER FROM AIR STATION DETROIT IS OUR PRIMARY RESOURCE THAT TIME OF YEAR. WHEN NOT RUNNING ON CASES WE ARE DOING STATION MAINTENANCE, PREPARING THE BOATS FOR THE BUSY SUMMER MONTHS AND GETTING QUALIFICATIONS FINISHED. WE NORMALLY PULL THE BOATS OUT OF THE WATER MID DECEMBER DEPENDING ON THE WEATHER. WE WILL PUT THEM BACK IN THE WATER IN THE BEGINNING OF MARCH.

WHEN THE BOATS ARE BACK IN THE WATER WE BEGIN RECERTIFYING ON OUR QUALIFICATIONS, OR GETTING OUR QUALIFICATIONS FINISHED. GETTING QUALIFIED TAKES APPROXIMATELY 3 MONTHS DEPENDING ON HOW FAST YOU CATCH ON TO THINGS. AFTER YOU ARE DONE WITH ALL THE BOATS YOU BEGIN WORKING ON BOARDING TEAM MEMBER QUALIFICATION'S. THAT IS WHEN YOU ARE TRAINED TO PARTICIPATE IN LAW ENFORCEMENT MISSIONS. BOARDING TEAM MEMBER USUALLY TAKES ABOUT TWO MONTHS TO COMPLETE. ONCE THE SUMMER MONTHS HIT (EARLY MAY) WE BEGIN OUR SAR SEASON AND GET BUSY. SAR SEASON ENDS IN LATE OCTOBER AND BETWEEN THOSE TIMES WE AVERAGE ABOUT 250-350 CASES. SOME DAYS IT SEEMS AS THOUGH WE NEVER STOP MOVING, OTHERS CAN BE VERY SLOW. STATION MARBLEHEAD IS ONE OF THE BUSIEST STATIONS ON THE GREAT LAKES EVEN THOUGH WE ONLY RUN 6 MONTHS OUT OF THE YEAR. WE ALSO DO LAW ENFORCMENT DURING THE SUMMER MONTHS AS WELL. AS BOARDING VESSELS TO CHECK TO MAKE SURE THEY HAVE ALL THE REQUIRED SAFETY ITEMS ON BOARD AND THAT THEY ARE NOT BOATING UNDER THE INFLUENCE. THE STATION HAS AN AVARAGE OF 800 BOARDINGS A YEAR, INCLUDING 20 PLUS BUI'S.

IF YOU ARE MARRIED YOU HAVE THE OPTION TO LIVE IN COAST GUARD OWNED HOUSING (IF AVAILABLE). THE COAST GUARD OWNED HOUSING INCLUDES: TWO FOUR BEDROOM HOMES AND SIX THREE BEDROOM HOMES. IF CG HOUSING IS NOT AVAILABLE, THERE ARE PLENTY OF PLACES IN THE AREAS TO LOOK INTO. RENT CAN RANGE FROM \$400 TO \$1200 A MONTH. THIS IS A RESORT AREA SO RENT CAN BE EXPENSIVE. THERE ARE A LOT OF THINGS TO DO AROUND HERE. YOU HAVE THE ISLANDS IF YOU LIKE TO GO OUT AND GET A FEW DRINKS OR JUST TO SEE THE HISTORICAL PARTS OF THE ISLANDS. CEDAR POINT AMUSEMENT (ROLLER COASTER CITY) PARK IS JUST DOWN THE HIGHWAY, AND THERE ARE MANY WILDLIFE PARKS IN THE AREA INCLUDING AFRICAN SAFARI PARK AND BACK TO THE WILD.
