Command Master Chief, Sector Lake Michigan

Master Chief Nutt assumed his duties as Command Master Chief of Sector Lake Michigan on July 1, 2021. His primary responsibility is to advise Captain Don Montoro, the Commander of Sector Lake Michigan, on issues and initiatives pertaining to all Coast Guard members and their families within the Sector Lake Michigan area of responsibility. Sector Lake Michigan includes a marine safety unit, a sector field office, nine stations, and two aids to navigation teams across Wisconsin, Illinois, Indiana, and Michigan. Most recently, Master Chief Nutt served as the Command Senior Chief for Base Ketchikan, Alaska.

Master Chief Nutt enlisted in the United States Coast Guard on February 23, 1999. His other previous assignments include USCGC HAMILTON, Charleston, SC; District Eight C4IT Branch, New Orleans, LA; District Eight Command Center, New Orleans, LA; USCGC MIDGETT, Seattle, WA; USCGC WAESCHE, Alameda, CA; Sector Corpus Christi, TX; USCGC MALLET, Corpus Christi, TX; and USCGC ACUSHNET, Ketchikan, AK.

Master Chief Nutt's personal awards include three Coast Guard Commendation Medals, five Coast Guard Achievement Medals, three Commandant Letter of Commendation Ribbons, and numerous other individual and unit awards. He has also earned the permanent Cutterman insignia.

A native of Houston, Texas, Master Chief Nutt is a graduate of the Navy Leading Petty Officer Leadership Course, Chief Petty Officer Academy class 153, and the Senior Enlisted Leadership Course class 72.
