

AETCM Nicolas Lanthier COMMAND MASTER CHIEF



Master Chief Lanthier assumed the duties of Command Master Chief (CMC) for Sector Lake Michigan in May 2023. Primary duties are to advise the Sector Commander on issues and initiatives pertaining to all Coast Guard members and their families. Sector Lake Michigan encompasses four states and 23 units with a work force of 500 Active Duty, 200 Reserve, and 1,000 Auxiliary personnel.

Prior to reporting to Sector Lake Michigan, Master Chief Lanthier served as the Command Master Chief for Aviation Training Center (ATC) in Mobile, AL acting as the primary adviser to the Commanding Officer.

Originally from Peterborough, New Hampshire, Master Chief Lanthier enlisted in the Coast Guard in 2002. Previous units include Aids to Navigation Team, Woods Hole, MA; C130-J Fleet Integration Team, Elizabeth City, NC; Air Station Cape Cod, Barnstable, MA; Air Station Barbers Point, Kapolei, HI; as well as Chief of the Fleet Integration Team, Waco, TX; Aviation Acquisition Branch (CG-931), with contract oversight and quality assurance for the Minotaur Mission System install on all C130-J aircraft.

Master Chief Lanthier is a proud graduate of the Coast Guard Chief Petty Officers Academy class 217, the Coast Guard Senior Enlisted Leadership Course class 92, and Spartan School of Aeronautics for Avionics Electronics Technician A-School.

Master Chief Lanthier is married to the former Kayla Sacht, originally from Charlotte, NC. and has one daughter, Aubree.
