Seamen are assigned to the Deck Department. Underway, Seamen will qualify as helm/lookout, and Quartermaster of the Watch (QMOW). Underway rotations are typically 1-in-3. All personnel must qualify in Damage Control. Occasionally opportunities exist to qualify as an ice rescuer, boat crew member, or boarding team member.

TYPICAL FA/FN JOB ASSIGNMENT:

Firemen are assigned to the Engineering Department. Underway, Firemen will qualify as an oiler. Underway rotations are typically 1-in-3. All personnel must qualify in Damage Control. Occasionally opportunities exist to qualify as an ice rescuer, boat crew member, or boarding team member.

INPORT WATCH TYPE AND DUTY ROTATION:

Two man duty section, depends on the amount of qualified watch standers and the port in which the cutter is moored.
