INPORT WATCH TYPE AND DUTY ROTATION FOR SA/SN/FA/FN: When first reporting aboard, you will be placed into a day worker status for two weeks. Following these two weeks the member will be placed into a duty section working 48 hrs on 48 hrs off with sliding weekends. You will have strict timelines for qualification, and will need to aggressively pursue them to become a fully qualified. Working on more than one qualification at a time is both encouraged and expected, as much material will carry over among certifications.


