Located in the Nation's third largest city, Marine Safety Unit Chicago has an Area of Responsibility that includes the Southern portion of Lake Michigan and the Illinois River watershed. 

ILLEGAL CHARTER ENFORCEMENT

Enacted 3 voyage terminations and 4 Captain of the Port Orders. Initiated criminal prosecution against an illegal charterer.

MTS MANAGEMENT

Collaborated with 200+ Industry Groups to permit significant events including Sail GP and the Chicago Air and Water Show. Close relations with Harbor Safety Committee improved waterways safety on the highly trafficked Chicago River.

POLLUTION RESPONSE

Oversaw cleanup of 7,600 gallons of pollution, including a significant spill following drydock collapse.
