ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Station Two Rivers is located on Lake Michigan in a small community of about 13,000 people. Two Rivers is a great small town that has a good relationship with the Coast Guard. The community is very safe and a great place to raise a family. There is an abundance of reasonable housing available between Two Rivers and Manitowoc. There are a few larger cities around such as Manitowoc, Green Bay, Appleton, and Sheboygan, which all have the usual amenities and shopping malls that aren't in Two Rivers. Milwaukee is an hour and half drive south and Chicago is about two to three hour drive south.

The station has one 25' RB-S, one 45' RBM that you will be required to qualify on. The unit is co-located with a Aids to Navigation Team that share the base. The AOR is beautiful and the station is historical. The station was established in 1880 and the current building was built 1940.

The station is equipped with a small weight room and the unit procures a membership to the local YMCA in Manitowoc (7 miles away) for each member free of charge. The YMCA has two large pools, two weight rooms, a large cardio room, multiple basketball and racket ball courts, with locker rooms and showers. The YMCA also has many different fitness classes and activities available to each member, most of which are free of charge. Manitowoc has eight recreational parks if you like to bike or just walk around. There is also a state forest nearby if you like wooded trails. Between Two Rivers and Manitowoc (famous for its shipbuilding) there are many historical museums throughout the two towns as well as restaurants and small town shopping.
