Directions from the nearest highway: From I-43 North, take exit for University Ave.-Sturgeon Bay (HWY 54/57N). 54/57 will change into 57 N after the Algoma exit, approximately 3 miles. Stay on 57 N Through Sturgeon Bay. Approximately 1 mile North of Sturgeon Bay 57 breaks off of 42 at a stoplight. Stay on 42 (straight through the light) into Northport, it's about 45 miles North of Sturgeon Bay. The car ferry to Washington Island is located at the end of HWY 42 at Northport.

General description of AOR: Station Washington Island's AOR is encompassed by a line from 45-05.3' N, 086-33.0' W to 45-05.3' N, 087-02.8' W (Cana Island Light) to 45-10.1' N, 087-14.2' W (Eagle Bluff Light) to 45-15.2' N, 087-29.8' W to 45-47.5' N, 086-22.0'W (Point Aux Barques) to 45-41.0'N, 086-06.0' W thence southwesterly along to the point of origin. During the winter season, Station Washington Island's AOR for SAR response will be absorbed by Station Sturgeon Bay. Station Sturgeon Bay is designated the parent command of Station Washington Island.
