Location: Station Bayfield is located within the Apostle Island National Lake Shore in the northern tip of

Wisconsin.

Unit's Primary Missions: Homeland Security, Search and Rescue, Law Enforcement, Public Affairs, Ice Rescue and Occasional Marine Safety / Aids to Navigation Support.

Assets: Currently the unit has one Response Boat Small (29306) and one Response Boat Medium (45653).





Area of Responsibility (AOR): Apostle Islands National Lakeshore

Uniform to Report-in: Tropical Blue Long or Service Dress Bravo. Call for appropriate uniform as it is seasonal.

Uniform of the Day: Operational Dress Uniform

Recommended Uniform Items In Addition To Seabag Issue: None

Operational Clothing: Foul weather gear and other operational clothing will be issued to member shortly after arrival. You're sponsor will ask what your typical clothing sizes (S, M, L) in order to purchase the appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) upon your arrival.

Personal Storage Space (in Cubic Feet): Very Limited. Member is assigned a locker for uniforms and operational clothing but there is approximately 70 sq. feet of locker space.

Exchange/Commissary: No exchange or commissary is located within the unit's AOR. Closest Exchange/Commissary is Duluth, 85 miles away. There is very limited selection of Coast Guard uniform items at the Commissary.

What Type Of Continuing Education Is Available In The Area: There are two (2) community college's within 25 miles of the unit. The Wisconsin Indianhead Technical College (WITC) and Northland College are located in Ashland, WI.

Special Procedures for Reporting After Hours: The Station is manned 24/7. However, advise your sponsor or XPO if you plan on arriving after hours.

Ratings Present at Unit: Station has only Boatswain's Mate (BM) and Machinery Technicians (MK).

Other Military Facilities: There is an Air National Guard base located in Duluth, MN, 85 miles away.

Religious Denominations in the Area: The surrounding areas are a host to all denominations.

Surrounding Area: Bayfield is located within the Apostle Islands national lakeshore. There are ample outdoor activities for everyone to enjoy. For example, hunting, fishing, kayaking, camping, snowshoeing, snowmobiling and skiing are all common activities in the area.

Name Of Nearest City and Distance: Ashland, WI has approx. 8000 year round residents and is located 25 miles away. Duluth, MN is 85 miles away with a population of 88,000 people. There is a mall and various other shopping areas located in Duluth.

Typical SA/SN Job Assignment: Boat Crewmember, Boarding Team Member, Communications Watch Stander

Typical FA/FN Job Assignment: Boat Crewmember / Engineer, Boarding Team Member, Communications Watch Stander

Duty Rotation: Two days on duty, two days on liberty with sliding weekends (working every other Friday, Saturday and Sunday)

Number of Personnel: Station has 15 active duty crewmembers.

Quarters/Barracks: No onboard quarters or barracks are available. The Station has duty rooms with racks for the Search and Rescue duty boat crew during the nights. Bring your own sleeping bag, food and toiletries.

BAH: All Station personnel, married or single, receive a Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) and live on the economy when they report to the Station unless assigned to government housing. The unit has four government houses.

Messing: Station is equipped with a small Kitchen, which has a stove, oven, microwave, deep sink, cookware, utensils, dishes and a refrigerator/freezer. Members are required to bring in their own meals to cook as there is no Food Service Specialist at the Unit. **Note**: Refrigerator space is limited.

Have A Junior Member Describe The Area, Job And Anything Else Of Interest To A Newly Arriving Member: The area is very beautiful between the lake, the islands and the outdoor nature it provides. It's a great first Station to be at. I've learned so much from everyone here. The winters are really cold. Summer time is perfect for outdoor activities. If you like a small guiet town and anything to do with nature, this is the place for you.

Quarters And Or Barracks Available: Although we live on board during our duty rotation, all newly reporting members will be placed on the economy. There are several areas to live in that are reasonably priced. Public transportation is very limited in the area.

Where Do Most People Bank: There are many banks in the area from small local banks as well as national chains.
