Safety Zone

In the interest of public safety, the Captain of the Port Jacksonville has established a safety zone on the St. Johns River in the vicinity of Fulton Cut. The safety zone has been established due to hazards associated with helicopter operations and the construction and deconstruction of power lines and towers. The safety zone will remain active until it has been deactivated by the Captain of the Port or their designated representative. Any person or vessel requesting to enter, pass through, or remain within the safety zone must request authorization from the Captain of the Port. Mariners are required to contact the Coast Guard via channel 16 to arrange for this authorization.
